ETEBA is a professional organization comprised of more than 200 large and small member companies that provide energy, technology, engineering, environmental remediation and waste management, and supporting services to private industry and various local, state, and federal agencies.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

ETEBA is proud to partner with member companies in offering high school seniors an exciting way to earn cash for college while also learning valuable lessons from work experience through intern positions. High school graduates enrolled in a full-time undergraduate curriculum at an accredited college, university or technical school by the fall term of 2010 are eligible for this rewarding program. ETEBA will award scholarships, valued no less than \$1,000, which can be applied to tuition, room and board, or books and other fees that may be incurred during the freshman year.

An internship may also be offered to a scholarship recipient. Intern positions vary from 2-8 weeks in duration and offer students an opportunity to gain valuable industry experience prior to entering college in their respective field of study. Students can earn a minimum of \$250 a week from participating member companies in a variety of positions over the summer prior to entering their freshman year at their selected institution of higher learning. Scholarship monies are paid directly to the school on the student's behalf and can be used to defray the cost of tuition, books, room and board and fees.

The goal of the Earn & Learn Program is certainly to assist students in meeting first year college expenses but most importantly to offer students an opportunity to experience the world of work while focusing their understanding of the many career paths available to them as they embark upon their college experience.

2010-2011 ETEBA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION & GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY

CANDIDATES MUST:

- 1) be graduating from high school with a diploma or equivalent by June 2010;
- 2) have a home address in Tennessee;
- 3) have applied to an accredited college, university, or technical school as a full-time student by the fall term of 2010;
- 4) have a high school grade point average of 2.5 or higher;
- 5) be pursuing a degree in environmental sciences, engineering, computer science, mathematics, or a science-related field; and
- 6) be willing to perform a 2-8 week paid work assignment (up to 40 hours per week) at an ETEBA member company during the summer of 2010 if an internship is offered.

SELECTION / AWARD

The ETEBA Education Committee will determine scholarship recipients. Selected applicants will interview with the selection committee, and recipients will receive notification of their selection by standard mail, e-mail, and/or telephone.

Award will be made directly to the school on behalf of the student by August of 2010.

- ✓ **Essay - minimum of 300 words and a maximum of 750 (typed, double-spaced)**
